The mission of the WATI Lending Library is to provide access to assistive technology equipment, software, and resources for children in Birth-3 programs and public schools in Wisconsin. The Lending Library offers short-term loans of 5 weeks including shipping time, free of charge. Items are available for preview and trial use to aid in selection for purchase. Items may be renewed for one 30-day period, if nobody is waiting for the item. You may email, fax, or phone in your requests, after you have submitted a signed loan agreement with us. Please provide the item number, along with the exact item name, with your requests.

WATI does not lend items directly to parents. Loan agreements must be signed by Birth-3 or public school staff. This aids in facilitating collaboration between school staff, parents and other professionals to ensure quality trials with equipment. A blank loan agreement has been included at the end of this catalog for your use, or you may download one from our website. Please feel free to make as many copies as needed. Please remember that requests for materials will only be filled after a signed loan agreement is on file with us for the current academic year.

Daily overdue fines have been implemented to ensure prompt returns and improve the efficiency of the Lending Library (See Loan Agreement for details regarding fines.)

It is important to note that while our service is statewide, our funding is limited. As a result, there may be some wait time for items that are in high demand. For this reason, there may be times when you will not be able to extend a loan.

# Catalog Organization

The WATI Lending Library has used a new numbering system for about a year. This system is a more organized way of grouping items and allows us to locate items on the shelves faster. Computer Access (1) is the first section of the new numbering system which is listed below. Each item in our library starts with a new 4 digit number, with dots separating digits. Items within each grouping are identified with a lower case letter following the last digit. For example, the first item classified as an expanded keyboard is 1.0.1.1a - Keytime 105+ Keyboard. The first item classified as a miniature keyboard is 1.0.1.2a - Unicorn 510 Mini Keyboard. Please refer to the catalog listings for all items in each category/grouping. ## Computer Access

A student with a physical disability may have difficulty handling the materials commonly used in the classroom such as books, pencils, crayons, and paper. While it is certainly possible to replace the need to access these simple materials by putting more things on the computer, that student may also have difficulty accessing the computer without adaptations or special peripheral devices.

### Alternative Keyboards

A way to help a student access a computer is with an alternative keyboard. A variety of alternative keyboards are available, including: expanded keyboards; miniature keyboards; large key keyboards; and light boards.

#### Expanded Keyboards

These are larger than the standard keyboard and are often flat surfaces that are custom programmable so that location, function and size of keys can be changed for individual users.

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## Mouse Alternatives

Mouse alternatives are devices that may let a person move the computer cursor more easily with their hand, or by not using hands at all. They include trackballs, joysticks, touchscreens, headpointers, and touchpads.

### Trackballs

A trackball works like an upside-down mouse. Instead of rolling the ball on the table by sliding the mouse around, the ball is moved directly by the user. The trackball does not need to be grabbed; only the ball must be nudged. Most people move the ball with their hands, but it can also be operated with a chin, elbow, foot, or stick held in the mouth. Trackballs come in many sizes, including ones that can be operated by a single finger. For people with limited fine motor ability, a trackball with a larger ball may be useful. Since the trackball remains in a stationary position on the desk or mounted on a stand, it can be a good option for a person with a limited range of motion.

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## Joysticks

A computer joystick is a directional pointing device that moves the computer cursor around the screen. Similar to a mouse in many ways, it differs in that the distance the stick is moved increases or decreases the speed of the cursor movement. Individuals who use a joystick to operate a wheelchair may have difficulty with a computer joystick as many wheelchair joysticks use all-or-none movements, that is, they do not incrementally change the speed. For this reason, a person with limited motor control may have trouble with the more precise control required to use a computer joystick.

## Touchscreens

Touch screens let a person touch items on a computer screen to make selections. Since the person points directly to what he wants, rather than moving an object to move a cursor to point to what he wants, it is cognitively easier to use. However, the user also needs to be able to reach up to the monitor.

## Touchpads

To operate a touch pad, a person moves his/her finger, or a stylus, around on a flat tablet. The cursor moves in a corresponding pattern on the screen. This can be a good solution for a person who is not able to grasp a device. Most touch pads require only a small range of motion, and some are as small as a 2 x 2 inch square.

Close observation of the individual's motor abilities is needed to select the best switch. The switch categories are: Pressure, Motion, Sound Sensitive, Pneumatic, and Photosensitive.

## Software – Voice Recognition

Voice recognition is a computer application that lets people control a computer by speaking to it. In other words, rather than using a keyboard and mouse to communicate with the computer, the user speaks commands into a microphone that is connected to a computer. Students can write using voice recognition in conjunction with a standard word processing program. When users speak into the microphone their words can appear on a computer screen in a word processing format, ready for revision and editing. Voice recognition technology can benefit students who have motor impairments limiting their use of a keyboard or who have learning disabilities that interfere with their ability to spell and write. If the students' oral language skills far exceed their ability to generate text with pencil and paper or standard word processing, voice recognition may enable them to become successful writers. For some, the visual-motor demands of keyboarding can be a major stumbling block that compounds the writing process. Similarly students who are the poorest spellers are frequently unable to effectively use standard spell checkers.

### Eye Gaze Frame or Board

This is a system where objects, pictures, or symbols are placed in such a way that the student can communicate by looking at the desired item. A vertical frame is frequently made out of PVC pipe or clear plastic frame with the pictures or other items placed several inches apart around the frame. This allows a communication partner to sit facing the student and accurately see where the student is looking as he gazes at the desired object or picture to communicate a choice or interest.

### Devices using Icon Sequencing or Semantic Compaction

Icon sequencing or semantic compaction is a way of organizing language, which uses an ordered array of pictures to code vocabulary. Minspeak is the primary example of semantic compaction and is used by Prentke Romich Company in their devices. The user presses two or three keys in sequence to produce one message. For example, using Minspeak, the user presses a button with a picture of a dog with a newspaper in its mouth followed by pushing a button with a picture of a question mark. The device produces the message, "What's new with you"? On the same device, pressing the picture of the clock followed by the picture of the question mark produces, "What time is it"? The user must be able to remember the message codes.

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### Devices using Dynamic Display

Pictures or words are presented on a screen, like a laptop computer with a touch screen monitor. By pressing a picture or word, the device either produces a message or branches to another screen of pictures or words. For example, to ask for a cheeseburger at McDonald's, the user selects a picture of food on the first page. The device automatically produces a new page of pictures, which includes a picture representing fast food. The user selects the fast food picture and the device produces a page with pictures representing several fast food restaurants. The user presses the picture for McDonald's and the device changes to a page that includes items on the McDonald's menu. The user selects the picture of the cheeseburger. This categorical method of storing messages allows a large number of messages to be retrieved, but still allowing each screen to remain fairly uncluttered.

Dynamic Display devices are available in a variety of sizes from those weighing over 9 pounds to the handheld variety, which weigh less than 2 pounds.

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### Reading, Studying & Math

This section focuses on assistive technology applications in the academic areas. It contains three separate areas: Reading, the more generic area of Learning/Studying, and Math. If a student has a specific vision of hearing impairment, you may want to look in those sections as well.

### Reading

A variety of alternatives can be considered for students who are struggling with reading, regardless of the disability. While there are only a small number of assistive technology "devices" for this population, there has been a proliferation of software developed in the last few years that can be extremely beneficial.

### Adapted Books

Books can be adapted for students at all reading levels. Some books be purchased already adapted. Others can be adapted by editing and simplifying the text, and adding graphic support using a variety of software programs. Become familiar with applicable copyright laws before adapting a book of any kind.

### Environmental Control

These are a means to interact and manipulate one or more electronic appliances such as: a television, radio, CD player, lights, and fan etc. This is accomplished using voice activation, switch access, a computer interface, and other adaptations.

Magnification is used to enlarge an object to a sufficient size to allow the student to receive and process the information.

# Hearing

## Hearing

Assistive technology for individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing fall into one of three categories: telecommunications, assisted listening devices (ALDs), and alerting devices. Persons with hearing impairments use amplified systems to assist with their hearing. However, they also rely upon their vision and their sense of touch, particularly vibrations, to supplement their reduced hearing capabilities.

### Portable Assistive Technology Devices

This section includes: phone amplifiers that can be built into the phone or can be external and either clamp on or connect to the phone; personal amplification systems that are most useful in one-to-one communication situations, car rides, and when watching TV; alert signalers, that can be positioned next to or connected to sound output devices, such as the phone, the doorbell and the fire alarm; and vibrating pagers that vibrate and either give the phone number to call or offer an alphanumeric window on which the caller can leave a detailed message.

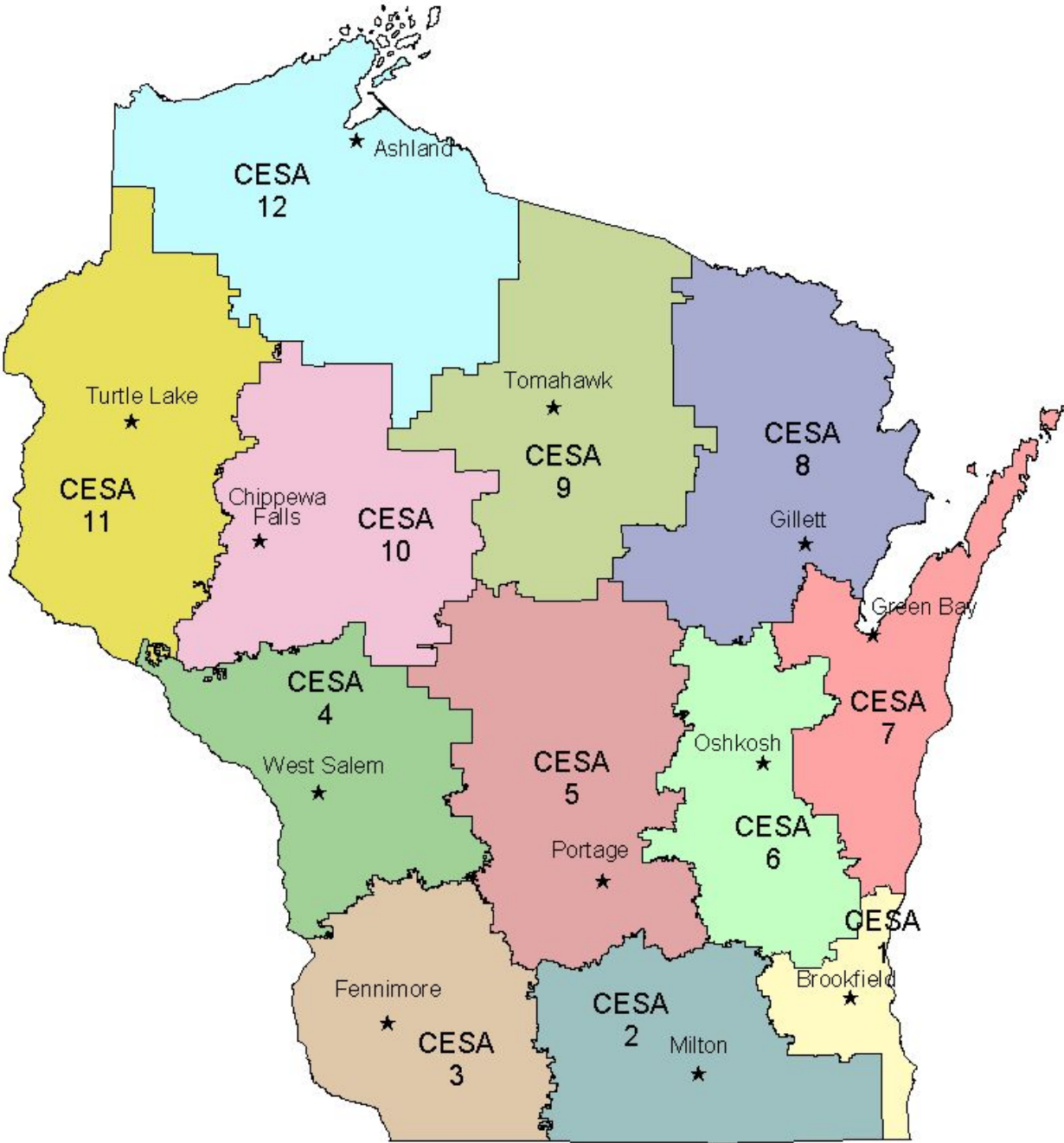
