But, how do you know if your students with limited verbal skills and or poor articulation are using word attack skills or even have the phonemic awareness to do so? This session will help teachers identify key literacy development stages and assess students (even those with severe physical & speech impairments) for phonemic and literacy development. Participants will receive an adapted phonemic assessment PowerPoint on a CD, literacy assessment forms, and start to create their own adapted phonemic assessment kit.
